To facilitate the processing of criminal appeals in this appellate district, beginning January 1, 2018, all parties are ordered to comply with the following rules:

Reporter's Transcripts in Felony Appeals

(a) Except as provided in (b), in felony appeals defendant's counsel is deemed to have requested under Code of Civil Procedure section 271, subdivision (a)(1) that his or her copy of the reporter's transcript be delivered in paper form.

(b) At any time prior to the printing of the reporter's transcript as provided for in (a) or within 15 days after the notice of appeal is filed, whichever is later, defendant's counsel, or, if the defendant is not yet represented by appellate counsel, the district appellate project, may serve the superior court with a request that defendant's counsel's copy of the reporter's transcript be delivered in electronic form.
