## MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

Rule 8.137(b)(2) of the California Rules of Court allows an appellant to apply to the court for permission to use a settled statement on appeal instead of a reporter's transcript where the appellant can show: (i) a substantial cost saving will result and the statement can be settled without significantly burdening opposing parties or the court; and either (ii) the designated oral proceedings cannot be transcribed; or (iii) although appellant does not have a fee waiver, he or she is unable to pay for a reporter's transcript and funds are not available from the Transcript Reimbursement Fund.

Appellant requests a settled statement for the trial in this action that took place on August 1 and 2, 2002. The proceedings were reported by a court reporter. The name of the court reporter is:

The declaration shows that a settled statement will result in a substantial cost saving, and the statement can be settled without significantly burdening opposing parties or the court. Also, [EITHER: the proceedings cannot be transcribed OR although appellant does not have a fee waiver, she cannot afford to pay for a reporter's transcript and there are no funds available from the Transcript Reimbursement Fund.] Without a reporter's transcript, the Court of Appeal will not be able to conduct a proper review.
