O R D E R

The adequacy of service of process has been contested in several recent writ proceedings filed by the Orange County Public Defender (OCPD), in particular with regard to timely and appropriate service of the Orange County District Attorney (OCDA). (See, e.g., G065129, G065132, G064402; see also G065163.)

Rule 1 of the Fourth Appellate District requires parties seeking immediate stays or other relief within five days of the filing of a writ petition to serve all opposing parties by: "(1) personal delivery or (2) an expeditious method consented to in advance by the party served."

The purpose of this administrative order is to ensure that OCPD and OCDA receive prompt and effective notice of writ petitions.

Effective March 3, 2025, all writ petitions (and any accompanying documents in support of the writ petition) filed by OCPD that require service upon OCDA shall be served by email on all email addresses designated

pursuant to this order by OCDA. Such service shall occur prior to the filing of the writ petition.

Similarly, effective March 3, 2025, all writ petitions (and any accompanying documents in support of the writ petition) filed by OCDA that require service upon OCPD shall be served by email on all email addresses designated pursuant to this order by OCPD. Such service shall occur prior to the filing of the writ petition.

This order applies to <u>*all*</u> writ petitions filed in this court by OCPD or OCDA, regardless of whether the petitioner is seeking immediate relief. However, this order does not apply in cases in which a real party in interest or respondent is not represented by OCPD or OCDA.

Pursuant to this order, the parties are DEEMED to consent to service by email of all writ petitions for purposes of compliance with Rule 1 of the Fourth Appellate District. Personal service on OCPD or OCDA shall not be required.

Within 10 days of this order, OCPD and OCDA are each ORDERED to identify at least one and up to five email addresses in a letter to this court. The clerk of this court is DIRECTED to append the letters to this order and serve the order again on OCPD and OCDA once the letters are attached.

Every OCPD and OCDA attorney that signs a petition filed in this court is ORDERED to personally ensure service by email of their counterpart agency as directed by this order.

OCPD and OCDA are ORDERED to distribute a copy of this order, with the letter attachments, to every attorney in their respective offices by February 28, 2025.

The parties may jointly request that this court vacate or modify this administrative order in the event they negotiate a preferable arrangement.
